- Goals of reducing the campus carbon footprint through research, education, or implementation



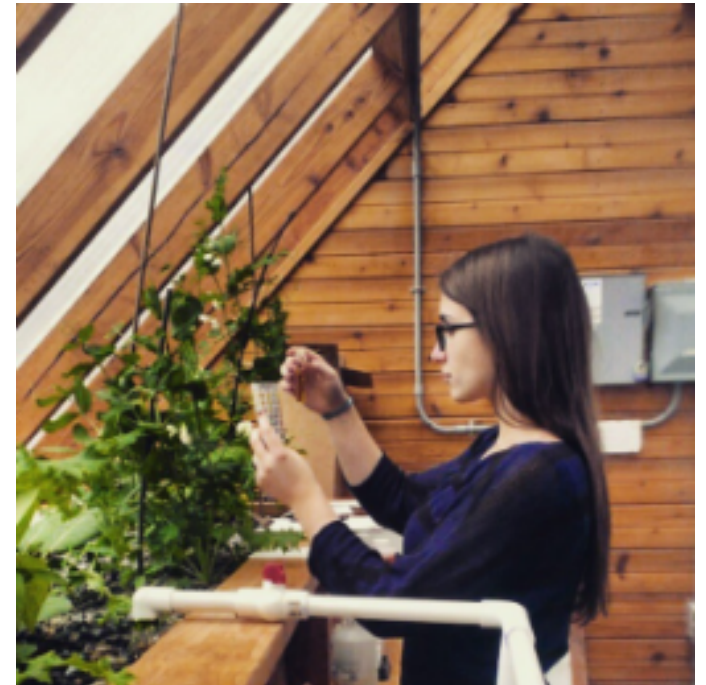
FOOD GUIDE

- Initial \$11,000
 - Media Based System
- Vertical Tower \$1, 756
- Re-Allocation \$5, 560
- Test Kits \$325
- Fish Food \$352
- Upkeep \$562
- pH Data Logger \$514
- Total over \$20,000 since 2011



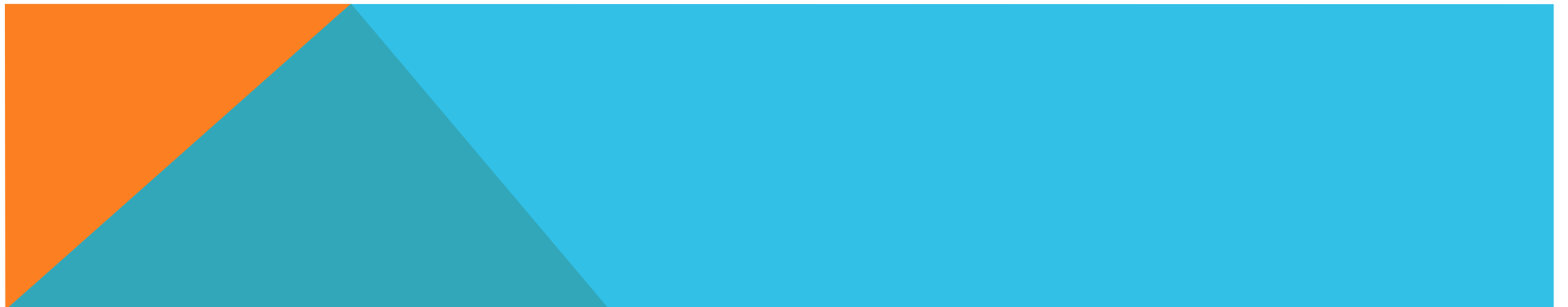
BUS PASS

- Prices for the bus system increased by 45% due to rising fuel costs
- This created a cash shortfall of \$75,000
- Instead of making a dramatic change with the student fee, it would be gradual with student funding

The Down Payment on Your Transit Pass?

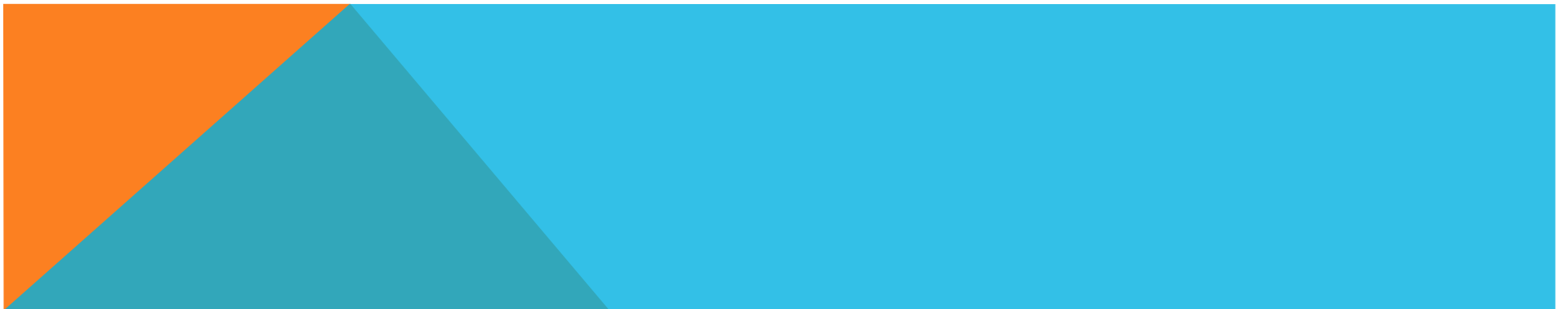

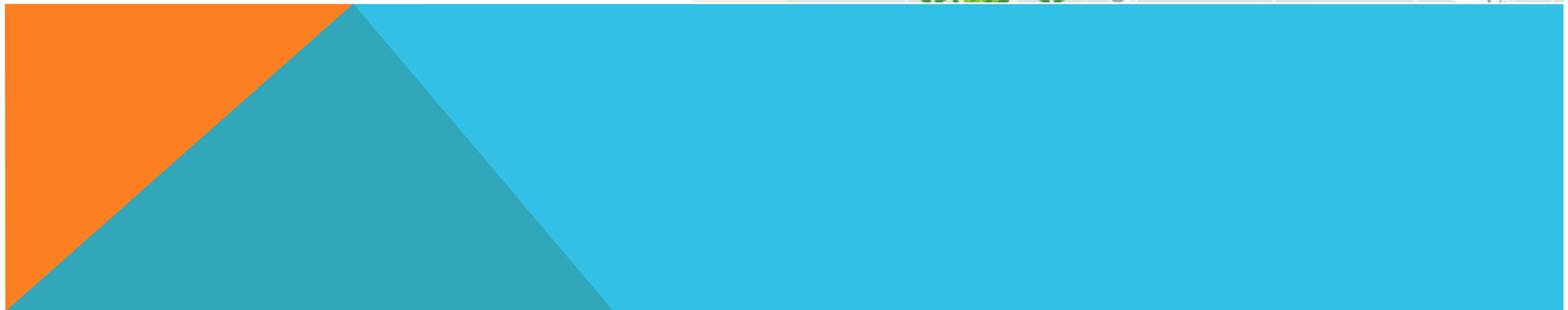
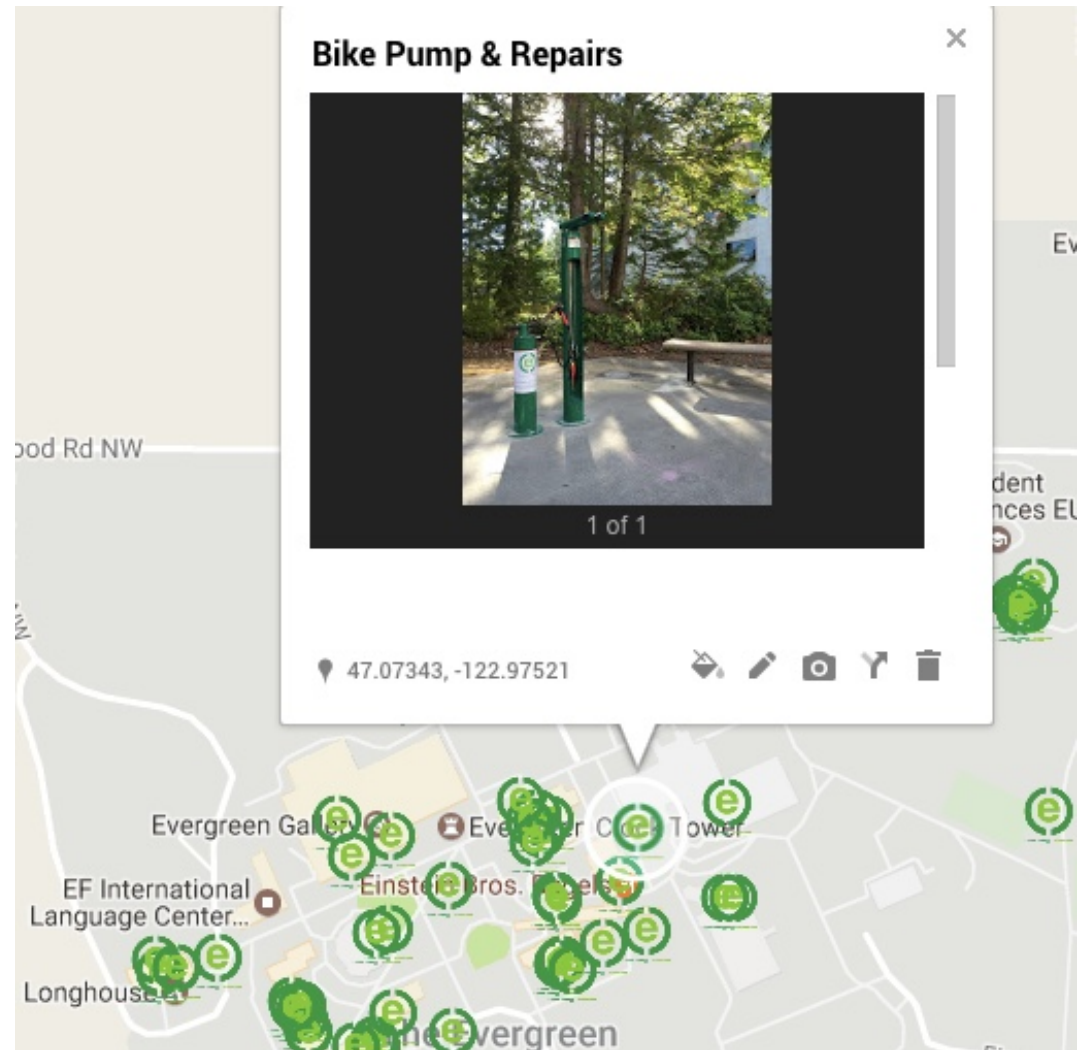
CHALLENGES WITH STUDENT LED INITIATIVES
